

Air Crash Awards Cut by Judge

A \$320,000 judgment award—Mrs. Nadine Nasalroad and her two children, survivors of a crash of a Trans World Airlines plane in the crash of two commercial airliners over the Grand Canyon in 1956 has been reduced by \$25,000. The judge said the \$75,000 for the Hatchers, could not be made by Judge Jesse J. Frampton.

The jurist ruled the awards made by a jury on Nov. 21. The judgments were against Trans World Airlines and United Airlines, whose planes crashed into the Grand Canyon, carrying 128 persons and three children of Ventura County Atty. William W. Hatcher. Atty. Irving H. Green, counsel for the Nasalroad family, said the award of \$100,000 to said the ruling was not acceptable.
